02	<ul> <li>If Employed</li> <li>Provide the following company letters on official letterhead, including the applicant's name, designation, and signature of the authorized signatory (Consulate general of Thailand): <ul> <li>Leave Sanction letter (OR) No Objection Certificate.</li> <li>Payslips of last 3 months.</li> <li>Company Appointment Letter (if the applicant has recently switched the company).</li> <li>3 years' ITR or Form 16 (Part A &amp; Part B) is required.</li> <li>Personal bank statement should be for the last 6 months with the bank's sign &amp; seal or E-Statement showing healthy balance.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
03	<ul> <li>If Self-employed         <ul> <li>Cover Letter on official business letterhead including the applicant's name, designation, and signature of the authorized signatory. (Consulate general of Thailand)</li> <li>Valid proof of Business Registration Certificate, such as GST certificate, Certificate of Incorporation, Partnership Deed, MOA, etc.</li> <li>For Partners, LLPs, or Directors: Business ITR for the last 3 years is required along with personal ITR</li> <li>For Self-Employed Individuals: 3 years' Personal / Company ITR</li> <li>Personal bank statement should be for the last 6 months with the bank's sign &amp; seal or E-Statement showing healthy balance.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
04	<ul> <li>Specific Mandates</li> <li>All documents should be in English. If a document is in any other language, an official translation of the same should be submitted.</li> <li>Embassy or Consulate may request additional documents or personal interview with the applicant on a case-by-case basis.</li> <li>If married &amp; name is not stated in passport then required marraige certificate.</li> </ul>
05	<ul> <li>Sponsor documents</li> <li>Sponsorship letter from the sponsor stating the applicant's details and particulars for the trip.</li> <li>Employment proof of the sponsor.</li> <li>Bank statement of the sponsor.</li> <li>Government ID proof (Passport, Driving license, PAN card) of the sponsor if the sponsor is from India.</li> <li>If the sponsor is from Australia, then a passport/driving license copy of the sponsor.</li> </ul>
06	<ul> <li>Minor Travelling Alone</li> <li>Obtain written consent from both parents or legal guardians.</li> <li>Provide signed copies of the passports or photo IDs of the parents or legal guardians.</li> <li>If applicable, include a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the parents.</li> </ul>
07	<ul> <li>Staying with friends and family</li> <li>Invitation letter from the invitee.</li> <li>Visa Copy or Resident Permit along with the ID/Passport of the inviting person.</li> <li>Address proof of the Invitor with the permanent address and contact number of the inviting person.</li> </ul>
