01	 Travellers Details Passport with a minimum validity of six months after expected date of arrival to Peru. Three recent coloured, passport-size photographs (4.3 X 3.5 cm) with white background. The face size should cover between 70% - 80% of the photograph. Two (DGC 005) forms duly typed or handwritten, in block letters and using black ink. Scan copy of Aadhar card
02	 Travel Details Hotel confirmation Arrival & departure air tickets Day by day detailed itinerary while in Peru.
03	 If Employed Provide the following company letters on official letterhead, including the applicant's name, designation, and signature of the authorized signatory (Consulate general of Phillippines): Leave Sanction letter (OR) No Objection Certificate. Payslips of last 3 months. Company Appointment Letter (if the applicant has recently switched the company). 3 years' ITR or Form 16 (Part A & Part B) is required. Personal bank statement should be for the last 6 months with the bank's sign & seal or E-Statement showing healthy balance.
04	 If Self-employed Cover Letter on official business letterhead including the applicant's name, designation, and signature of the authorized signatory. (Consulate general of Phillippines) Valid proof of Business Registration Certificate, such as GST certificate, Certificate of Incorporation, Partnership Deed, MOA, etc. For Partners, LLPs, or Directors: Business ITR for the last 3 years is required along with personal ITR For Self-Employed Individuals: 3 years' Personal / Company ITR Personal bank statement should be for the last 6 months with the bank's sign & seal or E-Statement showing healthy balance.
05	 Specific Mandates All documents should be in English. If a document is in any other language, an official translation of the same should be submitted. Embassy or Consulate may request additional documents or personal interview with the applicant on a case-by-case basis. If married & name is not stated in passport then required marraige certificate.
06	 Sponsor documents Sponsor in Peru or India should present a guarantee letter attesting that he or she will be responsible to bear some or all costs of boarding and lodging of the applicant, or repatriation, if needed. Valid identification document of the sponsor, e.g. Peruvian DNI, Aadhar card, Passport or any other valid national identification document. Proof of financial solvency of the sponsor, e.g. bank statements, fixed deposit.
07	 If Visiting for Business Purpose An apostilled invitation letter in English or Spanish from the business associate in Peru to be directly mailed at consular@embassyperuindia.in or faxed at +91-11-4616 3301. A formal letter from the company in which the person is employed, mentioning company profile and purpose of the travel of the applicant. A Letter from the recognized local chambers of commerce (FIEO, FICCI, APEDA, ASSOCHAM, PHD etc) confirming the company's registration details. Proof of registration of the company.

 If Visiting for Business Purpose Invitation letter for company on thier letter head with complete details of your trip. Bank statement of last 6 months with sign & stamp, company registration certificate & ITR of last 3 years of the company which will bare your travel expenses.
